Fear of the Lord

The book of Proverb says "the fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom." (Pro.1:7). We cannot have true wisdom unless we know who God is and create a sense of reverential fear of God.

This gift is often misunderstood and raises a question that is fear of the Lord out of love (reverential) or out of punishment? St. Thomas Aquinas in his "Summa Theologica" provides us a clear picture regarding fear of God. He enumerates two kinds of fear. They are servile fear which is fear of punishment and filial fear which is fear of reverence due to love. Fear of the Lord, therefore, is not servile fear but filial fear. Pope Francis describes this gift as a "filial fear," like a child's fear of offending his father, rather than a "servile fear," that is a fear of punishment. In other words, fear of the Lord is the joyful awareness or realization that we are finite and dependent creatures and we can find true consolation, fulfillment and peace in Him.

Fear of the Lord enlightens us with a following elements:

1. We should not offend God. our willingness or desire of not offending develops out of love. It is more than fear of punishment or sense of duty.
2. It motivates us to realize our sins and creates contrite heart.
3. It creates a deep understanding of God's love and concern for the humanity.
4. It instills a spirit of deep humility in dealing with others especially with inferiors.
5. Above all it helps us meet him on the day of judgment worthily.

While reflecting fear of the Lord let us examine ourselves.

1. Do I have fear of the Lord?
2. Do I have servile fear or filial fear or does fear of the Lord arise in me out of love or punishment?

Prayer: Loving God, I thank you for your unconditional love and care. Bless me to realize your goodness and greatness in my life. I ask this prayer through Christ our Lord. Amen.
